

SEX, DRUGS, AND ROCK 'N' ROLL

RESULTS SUMMARY 2023

In 2023, we conducted the annual Sex, Drugs, and Rock 'n' Roll survey. 794 young people aged 15–29 years completed the online survey. We asked about their **sexual behaviours**, knowledge of **sexually transmissible infections (STIs)**, **pornography use**, perceptions of **long COVID**, and **alcohol and other drug use**.

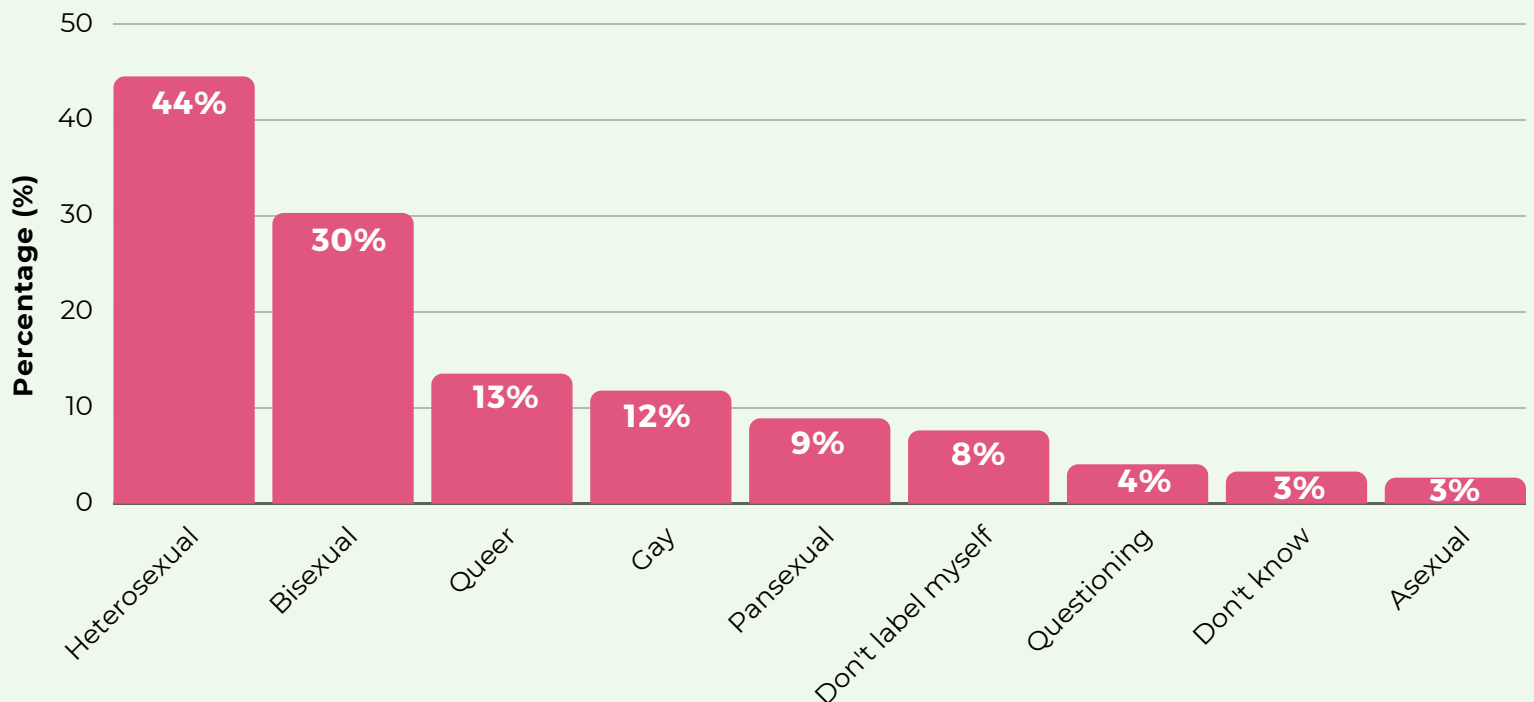
Demographics

- The average age was **23 years**
- **87%** were born in Australia
- **69%** were currently studying at high school, university, or TAFE
- **58%** lived with their parent/s

Gender Identity

- **55%** woman
- **34%** man
- **13%** non-binary

Sexual Behaviours

82% ever had oral sex

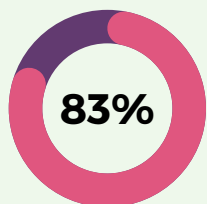
73% ever had vaginal intercourse

35% ever had anal intercourse

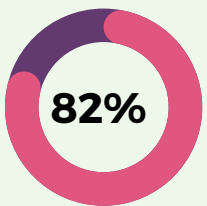
Of the 566 people who reported penetrative vaginal or anal sex in the past 12 months...

- **90%** had a regular partner (boyfriend, girlfriend, other partner)
- **38%** had a casual partner (one-night stand, friends with benefits)
- **34%** had a new partner in the past 3 months
- **57%** ever had an STI test
- **42%** used a condom the last time they had vaginal sex (n=558)

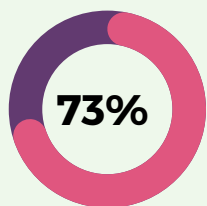
Knowledge of STIs



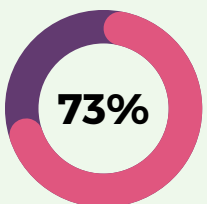
knew that if left untreated, chlamydia can last for years



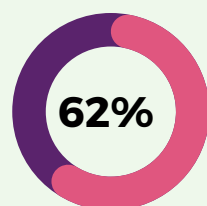
knew that people infected with STIs do not always have symptoms



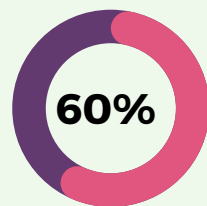
knew that taking the pill when young does not reduce fertility



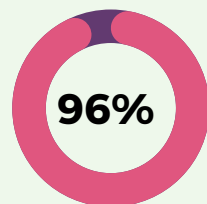
knew that gonorrhoea, syphilis, and chlamydia can all be treated with antibiotics



knew that chlamydia can make women infertile



knew that chlamydia can be diagnosed by a urine test



The oral contraceptive pill cannot prevent both pregnancy and STIs

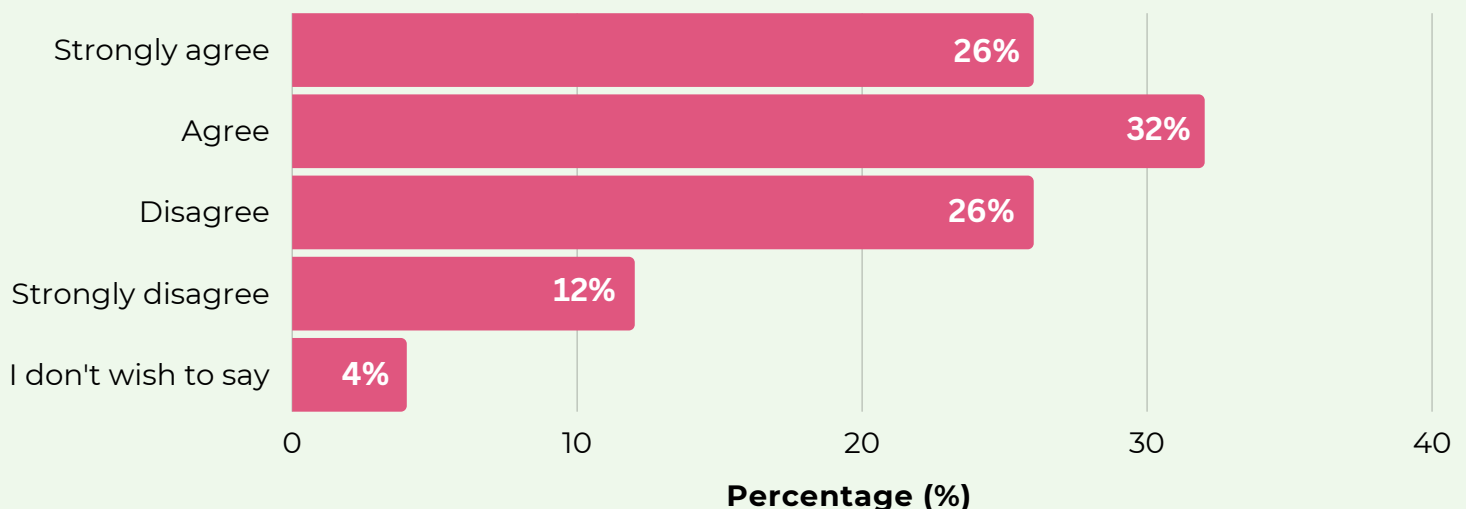

Long COVID

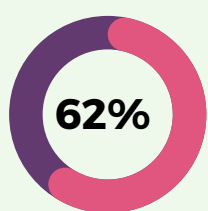
We defined as symptoms for >4 weeks following infection

- **79%** reported ever having a short-term COVID-19 infection
- **11%** of participants reported ever having long COVID
- **6%** had a current long COVID infection

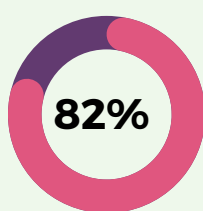
- **Almost half (49%)** of participants had family or friends who had experienced long COVID
- **15%** needed to support family or friends in managing their infection



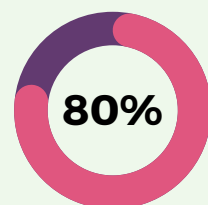
Impacts reported among those with a current long COVID infection (45 participants)



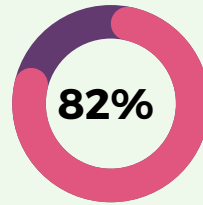
Cut down the amount of time spent on work or other activities



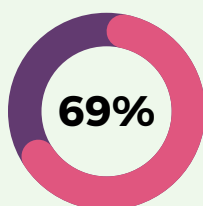
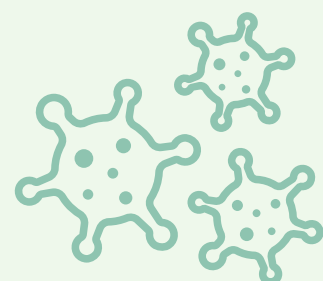
Had difficulty performing work or other activities

Alcohol & Other Drug Use

86% drank alcohol in the past year

50% had ever used an e-cigarette

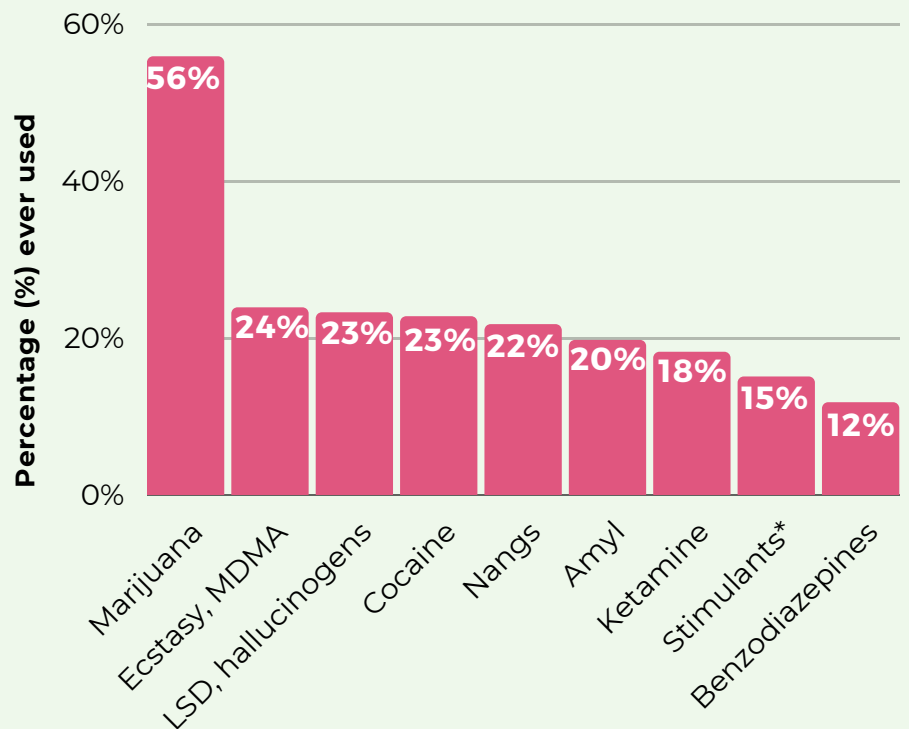
10% were current smokers

16 yrs

the average age participants reported drinking alcohol for the first time

Illicit Drugs

- **61%** had ever used illicit or non-prescribed drug
- Of these participants, **52%** had done so in the last month
